

S100 Fire Suppression & S185 Avoidance of Fire Entrapment

Certification: BC Ministry of Forests

11-16 Hours over 2 Days

Cost \$288.57 plus GST

Prerequisite: Student must present government issued photo identification. Due to COVID-19, it is mandatory for all students to wear a mask.

Valid: 1 Year, renewal available online after one year as long as ticket is still valid (Do not throw out your original ticket you will need that ticket each year to renew. A fitness test will be provided for students planning on fighting fire full time. The outdoor portion of the course will include fire pump setup, basic use of hand tools and Banana/Melon rolling of the fire hoses etc.

S185 Covers:

- Review case studies of Fire Crew deaths in 2 different incidents and learn from the review of both.
- Important points to avoid ever being trapped by a fire such as escape routes to a Safety Zone, Lookouts, Weather Reports & Communications.
- Importance of ICS, Chain of Command and a thorough Crew Leader briefing to avoid fire entrapment.
- Which areas on a fire that should absolutely be avoided to ensure crew safety.
