

Occupational First Aid Level 2 (OFA2)

Certification: Work Safe BC

\$900.00 Initial Certification must have prerequisites to attend course.

Prerequisite: First Time Students must hold a valid first aid level one certificate. Previous ticket holders must produce previous certification as a medic. Valid Government issued photo ID must be shown by all students. 100% attendance is required to be eligible for final exams. Student must be in good health and must be physically able to perform first aid related procedures, instructor may request a medical exam by a doctor which must be completed before student receives final certification. Student textbook & student guide must be purchased before class starts; this will secure your spot in the upcoming course. PLEASE NOTE: there is prereading to be completed before the first day of the course. Due to COVID-19, it is mandatory for all students to wear a mask, gloves and safety glasses or a face shield during the practical portions of this course.

This course provides a certificate for those students that want to work as a medic but MUST be within 20 minutes from a Hospital.

Certificate will be issued to students who pass a written exam with 70% and a practical exam with 70%.

Re-examination is available for \$170.00 plus Tax. Test must be done within 30 days of initial exam. Students that are unsuccessful after 2 exams will be required to do another 1-week course.
