

Transportation Endorsement (TE)

Certification: Work Safe BC

8 hours

Prerequisite: Students must produce valid Government Picture ID as well as a valid BC Level 1 First Aid or equivalent Ticket at registration. For the TE certificates to be valid students must have a valid level 1 or equivalent certificate. Please wear a T-shirt to class. Due to COVID-19, it is mandatory for all students to wear a mask, gloves and safety glasses/face shield during this course.

Valid: 3 years

Transportation Endorsement certification is required for a High Hazard workplace that has 10 or less employees on site and are more than 20 minutes surface travel away from a hospital. In this course you will gain the knowledge, skills and confidence necessary to provide effective emergency care until professional emergency medical care is available.

- Priority Action Approach & Principals of Transportation
- Priority Action Approach Review
- Packaging a Conscious Patient who requires Spinal Motion Restriction
- Packaging a Conscious Patient who does not require Spinal Motion Restriction
- Packaging an Unconscious Patient
- Caring for a Patient while in transport
