BLS Stand Alone Course covers:

- Glove Removal
- Primary Assessment
- CPR and AED
- Airway Obstruction
- Assisted Ventilation
- BLS Special Considerations

Airway Management covers:

- Opening the mouth
- Cross Finger Technique
- Tongue-jaw lift
- Airway adjuncts-insertion and removal
- Oropharyngeal (OPA) airways
- Nasopharyngeal (NPA) airways
- Supraglottic airways (Awareness only)
- Suction

Oxygen Therapy covers:

- Pulse Oximetry
- Supplemental oxygen
- Assemble/Disassemble Oxygen cylinders
- Oxygen regulators
- Oxygen delivery devices
- Administering Oxygen
