

Occupational First Aid Level Three (OFA 3)

Prerequisite: First Time Students must hold a valid first aid level one and transportation endorsement certificate. Previous ticket holders must produce previous certification as a medic. Valid Government issued photo ID must be shown by all students. 100% attendance is required to be eligible for final exams. Student must be in good health and must be physically able to perform first aid related procedures, instructor may request a medical exam by a doctor which must be completed before student receives final certification. Student textbook & student guide must be purchased before class starts; this will secure your spot in the upcoming course. PLEASE NOTE: there is prereading to be completed before the first day of the course. Due to COVID-19, it is mandatory for all students to wear a mask, gloves and safety glasses or a face shield during the practical portions of this course.

Valid: 3 years, Recognized Canada wide

This course provides certification for those who want to work as a medic in the Oil and Gas, Mining, Plants, Forestry industry etc.... There could be an opportunity to operate a mobile treatment centre (MTC) vehicle.

Certificate will be issued to students who are able to pass both a written exam with 70% and both practical exams with 70%. Re-examination is possible for \$170.00 plus GST for 1 exam (trauma) and \$200 plus GST for 2 exams (trauma & medical). Re-examination must be done within 30 days of initial examination otherwise they will be required to repeat the 2-week course. Students who are unsuccessful after 2 examinations will be required to do another 2-week course. The second course will be free to students provided they maintain 100% attendance in the initial course, this will be up to the agency's discretion; however, the exam fee will still apply.
